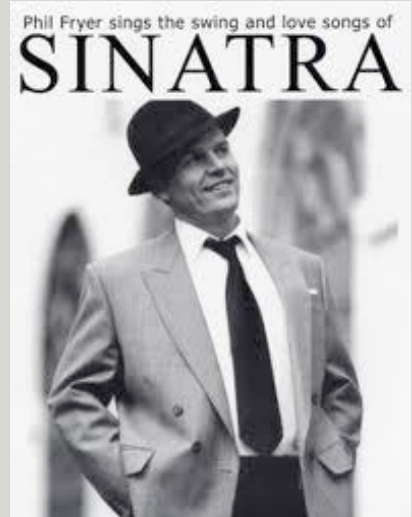
### Vice President's Report

Following on from the AGM we had the other Wednesday and the way it unfolded you would think it was the first time the Club had shown a loss. Now I am not being flippant, but lets put things into perspective. If we had not reduced our profit margin from 48% down to 43% the beer price in the Club would be higher than what they are now, so that's a reduction. In real terms, we lost out on £14,500 of profit in doing that. We also put £10,000 into our Building Fund account. The unexpected payment

to HMRC of nearly £9,000 and the outcome would have been different. The Committee are always looking at ways to save money and bring down costs. The Solar Panels will start generating some income this year if the forecasters are to be believed. Also, we should see the final phase of our upgrade to the heating system so it can be zoned to rooms that are open and not heating rooms that are not. But be ready for some austerity measures and belt tightening by this Committee. Don't forget we are all in this together.
