



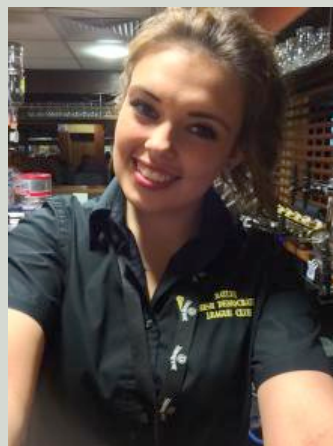

Other countries include Los Pastos Sauvignon Blanc and a Merlot from Chile. Moondarra Chardonnay and a Shiraz from Australia.

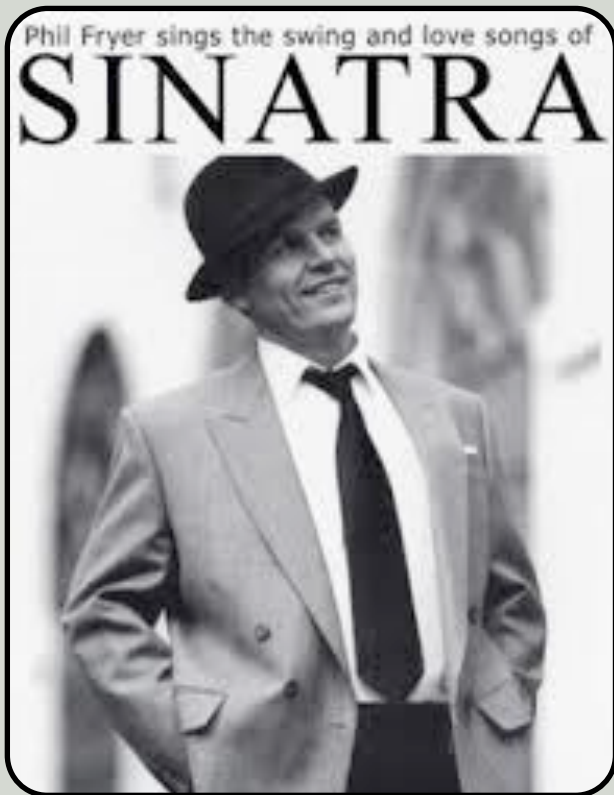
New Menu's will be distributed on tables when the wines are ready and available for purchase. Please keep and eye out.
