Sadly he's already served his last shift here with us. Officially finishing on Sunday 18th June.


But we still wanted to give him a mention and the prestige of being hosted on the front cover of our Newsletter!

- 5. New sink and cupboard replacement behind the Bar.


If any of Members have any particular interest in these areas of work, wish to quote for any jobs currently in planning please don't hesitate to contact us for more information.
