Updates from The Secretary



Thanks again for reading. It's always nice to share news on what's happening.

I suppose lots of things go on and take place and for me its remembering whats we've done or doing that I often struggle with. I try to write down as much stuff as I can.

First thing, Lounge Carpet. We've finally decided on a manufacturer and a design. We're just waiting on quotations from Fitters. Once that has reached us we can decide and move forward with giving the order and putting the carpet into production. It takes between 6-8 weeks for it to be made. Nearing the completion of the carpet, work on redecorating the Lounge will begin. We're hoping this will only take approx 5 days. Again, we'll keep you posted nearer the time.

Secondly, update on Games Room windows. After receiving 3 quotes, the Committee decided to choose Jade Windows. An initial deposit has been made and work has already started. We've asked for a similar look to what we currently have now. So when complete it should be hard to even tell at first glance they've been renewed.

Thirdly, refurbishment of the Gents Toilets. No real progress has been made on this project yet. As were still waiting for quotations on the work we've asked for. Naturally, we want to get this right this time. As usual we'll keep you posted as things develop more.

In terms of big projects that's about it for now.

We are however looking into our Car Park, handing over the running of it to a third party company. At this stage its only an idea and we've not even really begun looking at the logistics of it properly yet. Anything we do decide we'll give our Members time and notice.

Following a recent meeting, some staff have expressed an interest in learning some basics of 'sign language'. Which we think is very admirable and will look into what we can do for those wanting to learn.

With the redecoration of the lounge forthcoming, we're also looking at fitting in a book shelf. Batley Library have kindly donated the books, they'll be available for Members to borrow and read. This links in nicely with the launch of our Book Club.

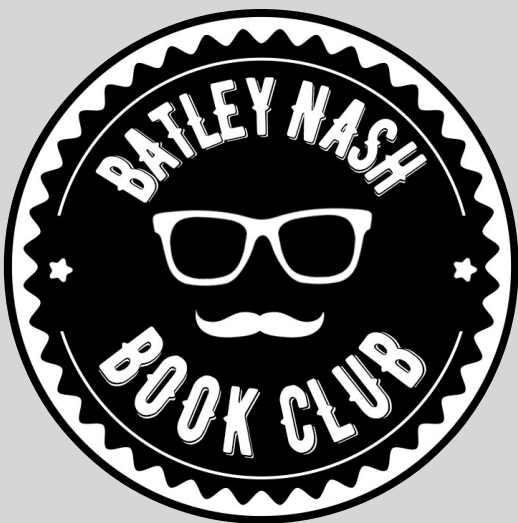
