IT'S BACK.



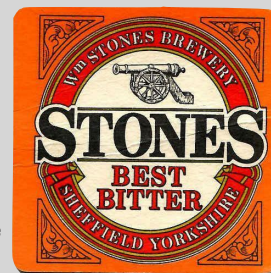

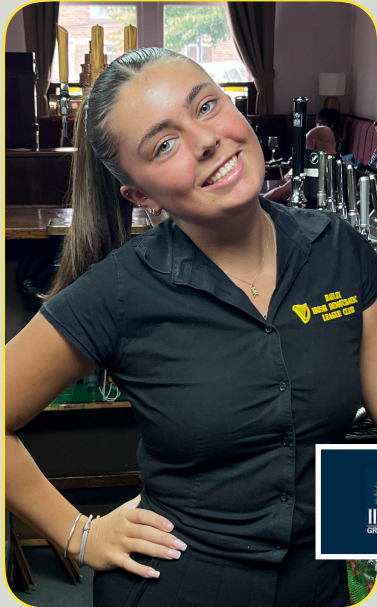


IS IT TIME TO SAY GOODBYE?
